POSITION DESCRIPTION

Under general supervision, this position provides public health nursing services to pregnant and postpartum women, infants, toddlers, and their families in homes and community settings. Performs other duties as required. This position is supervised by the Maternal Child Health Outreach Services Team Leader.

WORK PERFORMED

- **50%** Nursing Process. Performs health, development and nutrition assessments on pregnant women, infants, toddlers, and postpartum women. Assesses clients' needs based on gathering of information, histories and screening tests. Provides education, information, support and guidance to families and makes appropriate referrals based on findings. Focuses on early intervention, health/nutrition education, breastfeeding education/support and anticipatory guidance for families. Work is centered around obtaining positive outcomes by improving the health of pregnant women and babies through reducing the prevalence of birth defects, premature birth and infant mortality. Teach group education classes to pregnant women and their support person.
- **30% Documentation**. Maintains timely, complete and accurate documentation in the family health record including documentation of referrals and reports to other care providers in order to assure the health of families served. Complete chart abstractions.
- **10% Quality Assurance/Team Process**. Participates in all necessary training to ensure understanding of and adherence to MCH guidelines. Participates on various inter-Department and intra-Department teams to assure continuity and consistency in service delivery as defined by protocols, procedures, grants and program standards.
- **10% Program Responsibilities.** Adheres to nursing standards of practice and follows Department procedures and protocols as well as local, State and Federal regulations. Will travel to client homes, various community sites and satellite clinic locations as needed to deliver services. Completes accurate program time studies and travel reports.
