POSITION DESCRIPTION

Under general supervision, this position has limited law enforcement powers pertaining to animal control ordinances. Performs other duties as required. This position is supervised by the Operations Chain of Command.

WORK PERFORMED

- **43% Daily Work.** Drives a truck and routinely patrols the County to capture unleashed, unlicensed, vicious, diseased and injured animals. Responds to and investigates complaint calls regarding animals that are creating a nuisance. Removes animals from under houses, on roofs and in trees. Traps, tranquilizes and destroys animals when unable to utilize other methods of capture.
- **15%** Transportation of Animals. Transports animals to animal shelter.
- **15% Daily Records.** Keeps records and reports on animals picked up and related work activities.
- **15% Public Service.** Provides the general public with information relating to pet owner responsibilities as well as applicable animal control and licensing ordinances.
- **6% Criminal Charges.** Investigates possible code and ordinance violations as they relate to animal control. Serves citations.
- **5% Dead Animal Disposal.** Retrieves and disposes of deceased animals.
- 1% Bite Records. Locates animals that have bitten humans. Arranges for quarantines of animals.

- Use and perform maintenance on firearms and other police equipment.
- Operate a sheriff vehicle in a variety of conditions.
