POSITION DESCRIPTION

Under general supervision, this Intermittent position assists Public Works Road and Bridge crews in several different areas and performs duties as assigned. Operates a variety of construction equipment to repair and maintain roads and signs. Performs other duties as assigned. This position is supervised by an Assistant Road Supervisor.

- May act as flag-person or drive a pilot vehicle to direct traffic through or around a construction area.
- May conduct infrastructure facility inventory inspections.
