## **POSITION DESCRIPTION**

Under general supervision, this position primarily provides health care services in the area of Immunizations. This position also provides assistance with services related to Infectious Diseases, Tuberculosis, Sexually Transmitted Infections, Family Planning, and Public Health Emergencies. Recommends and provides vaccines in accordance with guidance from Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and instructs patients on preventive health care. Performs other duties as required. This position is supervised by a Health Services Team Leader.

#### WORK PERFORMED

- **40% Direct Patient Care.** Interviews patients in order to record their health history. Administers medication, immunizations and other treatments according to prescription, protocol, or direction. Performs limited evaluations of patient's health status based on standing orders. May perform limited, routine lab duties, obtain specimens, and complete lab forms as indicated. Assists with providing other remedial actions designed to ensure the health of patients and safety of the community as related to infectious disease issues. Communicates with patients, pharmacies, and other health care providers.
- **20% Documentation/Certifications.** Maintains appropriate and complete medical records. Completes the required documentation for reimbursement and program accountability. Assists in keeping data and statistics in accordance with grant and governmental regulations. Completes ongoing continuing education activities regarding Immunizations, Infectious Disease, Tuberculosis, Sexually Transmitted Infections, Family Planning and other pertinent topics. Obtains/Maintains laboratory proficiency by completing quarterly testing if performing moderate or high complexity testing. Obtains/Maintains HIV counselor certifications if performing HIV testing and counseling services.
- **15%** Triage. Triages phone calls and walk-in patients for proper service and care.
- **10% Case Management.** Assists patients by providing information and direction relative to treatment procedures or health conditions as instructed by providers and applicable guidelines. Performs disease control activities including investigations, contact tracing, testing, referrals, and individual, provider, and community education.
- **10% Emergency Preparedness.** Works with the Community Health Outreach and Planning programs to address epidemiological capabilities and the capacity to institute active surveillance of agents, injuries, or disease. May require response during non-business hours via phone notification. Participates in an on-call 24/7 rotation with other Clinical Services nurses.

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**5% Departmental Support.** Follows Shawnee County Rules and Regulations and Department policy. Stocks, orders and rotates supplies as needed. Individual may drive to various County and satellite locations within Shawnee County.
