POSITION DESCRIPTION

Under general supervision, this position will perform major and minor mechanical repairs on various kinds of gasoline and diesel powered equipment. Performs other duties as required. This position is supervised by the Auto Mechanic Supervisor and Assistant Equipment Fleet Supervisor as necessary

WORK PERFORMED

- 25% Scheduled Services.** Performs scheduled services on large and small vehicles, heavy construction equipment and agricultural equipment. Maintain a clean work area & work equipment.
- 20% Mechanical Repairs.** Inspects, diagnoses and repairs mechanical defects in heavy trucks, graders, rollers, street sweepers, mowers, tractors, passenger vehicles and other mechanical equipment.
- 10% Hydraulic Repairs.** Repairs hydraulic systems on heavy construction equipment, agricultural equipment, heavy trucks, passenger vehicles and other related equipment..
- 10% Brakes.** Replaces or repairs all brake components and perform brake adjustments.
- 10% Auxiliary.** Installs auxiliary equipment, batteries, tires, wiring and lighting.
- 10% Air Conditioning.** Repairs air conditioning systems on large and small vehicles, heavy construction equipment and agricultural equipment.
- 5% Record Keeping.** Maintains records of repairs made, work orders and time worked.
- 5% Welding.** Performs welding and structural repairs.
- 5% Miscellaneous.** Other maintenance tasks as required or directed.

- The principles and operation of gasoline and diesel engines.
- Methods, tools, equipment and materials used in the repair and maintenance of motorized construction equipment, agricultural equipment, trucks, automobiles and small engines.

- Occupational hazards and safety of the trade.

High School Diploma or GED Certificate.

Four (4) years' experience as a heavy equipment, agricultural equipment mechanic within the past eight (8) years. Experience with small engines a plus Two (2) years related vocational training may be substituted for the required experience on a year-for-year basis.

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Valid Kansas Class B Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with tanker endorsement and eligible to operate a County-owned vehicle HR-2013-2 If no CDL is available, a valid Kansas Driver's License and proof of having passed the Kansas Class B Commercial Driver's License examination.

Driving record that shows: No misdemeanor or felony convictions for traffic/vehicular offenses (DUI, vehicular homicide, reckless driving, hit and run, etc.) on the driving record that are less than five (5) years old; No more than two (2) at fault or chargeable accidents on their driving record that are less than five (5) years old; No more than two (2) traffic infractions (speeding, failure to yield right of way, etc.) that are less than one (1) year old.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Required to pass a pre-employment/periodic CDL physical(s)/drug screen(s) and a review of driving record.

Required to lift sixty (60) pounds.

A valid Kansas Class B Commercial Driver's License with tanker endorsement is required within one (1) month of hire date (if not available at the time of hire).
